## "STAY QUIT TO WIN" CHALLENGE

**Kuujjuaq, February 20, 2012** – The Nunavik Regional Board of Health and Social Services (NRBHSS) is continuing its efforts to help smokers quit smoking. Once again, this year the "Stay Quit to Win" Challenge will begin on March 1, 2012, and end on April 11, 2012, for a total of six weeks.

Each registered participant will receive a brochure and a CD to encourage and help them in their efforts at quitting smoking.

The challenge is open to all *Nunavimmiut* smokers aged eight years and older.
