

Additional Instructions for Hunting, Fishing and Gathering Activities

SUMMARY

Travel by boat

- Boats are limited in space and social distancing is not possible on board.
- Crew members spend several hours or days together. The most important thing is to make sure that persons who board a boat:
 - have no COVID-19 symptoms;
 - are not positive COVID-19 cases;
 - are not waiting for results of COVID-19 testing;
 - are not in a period of isolation after returning from a trip outside Nunavik.
- Limit the number of members from different households on board the boat. There is no defined maximum of authorized persons, as that number depends on the size of the boat.
- Disinfect the surfaces on the boat often.

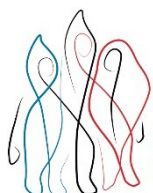
Members of COVID-free communities may visit one another by boat.

Fishers may continue stopping in other communities for fuel as long as contact is limited. More information will be provided if new cases occur. Stay tuned for news!
