Kuujjuaq, June 12, 2015 – Throughout the month of June, Elders' Month, the Nunavik Regional Board of Health and Social Services (NRBHSS) invites all *Nunavimmiut* to unite against elder abuse. Specifically dedicated to elders, the month of June includes World Elder Abuse Awareness Day on June 15.

On June 15, everyone is invited to tune into a regional radio broadcast on TNI (FM 94.1) between 9:00 and 11:00 a.m. The NRBHSS also encourages the population and organizations to support and participate in the various local and regional activities that will be held throughout the month of June.
