## DECISION OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE NUNAVIK REGIONAL BOARD OF HEALTH AND SOCIAL SERVICES

**Kuujjuaq, December 8, 2011** – At the 76<sup>th</sup> session of the board of directors held in Kuujjuaq on December 6, 2011, a letter of recommendation prepared by the firm Raymond Chabot Grant Thornton was tabled. The Nunavik Regional Board of Health and Social Services (NRBHSS) wishes to point out that everything will be done to ensure compliance and application of the recommendations.

In response to a reference in the letter concerning the inappropriate use of credit cards, the board of directors will ask an independent third party to review the situation in order to ensure that, if necessary, corrective action is taken.

No interview will be granted.

The NRBHSS is a public agency created in 1978 under the **James Bay and Northern Québec Agreement**. It is responsible for nearly the entire Québec territory located north of the 55<sup>th</sup> parallel in terms of the provision of health and social services for the inhabitants of the 14 communities.
