NRBHSS EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR AWARDED BY HUMAN RIGHTS COMMISSION

Kuujuuaq, December 11, 2015 – The Nunavik Regional Board of Health and Social Services would like to congratulate Executive Director Minnie Grey and 39 other recipients for being honoured by the Quebec Human Rights Commission. On the 40th anniversary of the organization, the *Commission des droits de la personne* will honour Mrs. Grey in Montréal on December 10.

“We are proud to pay tribute to these individuals who, every day, take action to uphold the principles set out in the Charter,” said Commission President Jacques Frémont in a December 7 release.

We applaud the recognition of Mrs. Grey, whose efforts throughout her career have centred on the well-being of *Nunavimmiut*, as well as the other recipients of this award.

The NRBHSS is a public agency created in 1978 under the James Bay and Northern Québec Agreement. It is responsible for nearly the entire Québec territory located north of the 55th parallel in terms of the provision of health and social services for the inhabitants of the 14 communities
