Kuujuuaq, December 4, 2012 – The board of directors of the Nunavik Regional Board of Health and Social Services (NRBHSS) is pleased to announce the appointment of Minnie Grey as Executive Director of the NRBHSS. Meeting for the 88th session of the NRBHSS board of directors from December 4 to 6, 2012, the members unanimously adopted the selection committee’s recommendation.

Mrs. Grey has held various positions during her career, including a previous stint as Executive Director of the NRBHSS as well as head negotiator for Nunavik’s regional government. In February 2012, she received a recognition award from the National Aboriginal Achievement Awards.
