

The Public Health Department invites health professionals to **report any situation** deemed **unusual** or **concerning** related to an alcohol, drug, or opioid overdose, namely:

- The overdose case meets a **severity criterion** (e.g., intubation, hospitalization, death, etc.).
- The **number of overdose** cases is **higher than usual**, OR
- The **symptoms** of the overdose are particularly **severe** or **unusual** for the substance consumed, OR
- The **circumstances are unusual**.

To submit a report:
