Pre and Post Natal Food Coupons	Food coupons are distributed for the purchase of healthy foods during pregnancy, after childbirth and during the breastfeeding period. Coupons are provided by the Ilagilluta (SIPPE) community workers or the Social Services HRO	(819) 338-3218
Nirivik Canteen	The Nirivik Canteen is operated by the pre work training program at the Arsaniq school. The canteen operates cooking classes, and prepares frozen meals made available daily to students in need of lunch. Additionally, healthy snacks are distributed to the whole student body daily through the canteen	(819) 338-3332
