

# Guidelines for the Resumption of Medical Internships

## Background

Performing internships in all disciplines is an excellent method of recruitment. However, internships have been suspended for several weeks due to the COVID-19 pandemic. We are planning to resume medical internships in the various communities of Nunavik in September 2020.

## Guidelines

In order to insure a safe and optimal return of medical interns, it is recommended that:

- Each health center accommodates only one student at a time
- All students will be required to complete an online questionnaire before departure, like the rest of the staff.
- Students will also have to submit to the travelers' screening program under the Nunavik Director of Public Health:

- Ideally, students should be quarantined in the South for 14 days prior to arrival. If this is not possible, each health center will apply the quarantine measures that are recommended for essential workers in Nunavik:
