

ORDINANCE 2021-23

Date: November 17, 2021

Subject: **Orange Plus**-level measures in the Nunavik communities

WHEREAS the risk of transmission of COVID-19 remains present in all the Nunavik communities, even those where no cases have been reported recently;

WHEREAS despite the presence of cases of COVID-19 in some communities, the risk of acquiring infection can be controlled by putting in place preventive measures;

WHEREAS preventive measures are necessary to protect the health of the population;

WHEREAS these preventive measures must be proportional to the risk of COVID-19 in the community;

The following measures are applicable for **Orange Plus** alert level:

Any person with symptoms compatible with COVID-19, such as fever, unusual cough, breathing difficulties, loss of the sense of taste or smell, nasal congestion, sore throat, unusual fatigue and headache, or any person who believes he or she has been in contact with a person with COVID-19 must refrain from frequenting any public place or visiting other homes. An appointment must be obtained for COVID-19 testing.

Restrictions on travel, as identified in Ordinance 2021-16-1 dated November 14, 2021, shall remain in effect until further notice.
