

## **ORDINANCE 2022-12**

Date: April 11, 2022

Subject: Lifting of measures related to travel in Nunavik

WHEREAS community transmission of COVID-19 has been documented in all Nunavik communities;

**WHEREAS** the COVID-19 vaccine protects against serious infections and Nunavimmiut have been offered vaccination;

WHEREAS the consequences of COVID-19 in Nunavik are comparable to those elsewhere in Quebec;

**WHEREAS** as of April 11, 2022, Transport Canada's Interim Order Respecting Certain Requirements for Civil Aviation Due to COVID-19 is still in place and requires, among other things, a proof of vaccination against COVID-19 to be presented to the carrier (or in exceptional circumstances a COVID-19 test result);

The regional director of public health, acting in accordance with section 106 of the Public Health Act, suspends all differentiated public health measures related to COVID-19 in Nunavik including those related to travel.

The public health measures in force (in public places, workplaces, public transportation, etc.) are those enacted by the Government of Quebec.

This ordinance does not replace Transport Canada's Interim Order Respecting Certain Requirements for Civil Aviation Due to COVID-19.

This ordinance replaces ordinance 2022-11 (March 12, 2022).
