Kuujjuaq, April 9, 2018 – The Nunavik Regional Board of Health and Social Services (NRBHSS) is proud to announce a graduation ceremony in Salluit for students who successfully completed one of the two occupational-training programs in Communications in Supportive Relations and Communications in Administration, offered jointly with the Cégep Marie-Victorin.

For the 2016-2017 school year, the cegep had 60 students and nearly 25 of them successfully completed their training program. "It is important to emphasize these graduates' accomplishment, as their perseverance and success are a great source of inspiration for many of us," mentioned Minnie Grey, Executive Director of the NRBHSS. A total of five students will receive their diploma.

The ceremony will be held in: **Salluit** – On April 20 at the community centre at 1:30.

The entire community is invited to attend the event and congratulate the graduates. Snacks will also be served on site.

The Nunavik Regional Board of Health and Social Services is a public agency created in 1978 under the James Bay and Northern Quebec Agreement.
